- 1. Admission for fresh Students will be done through Selection Board.
- 2. Admission to the School implies full acceptance of the Rules and Regulations of the School.
- 3. The following documents are to be furnished while applying for Admission.
 - a) Photo copy of HSLC Marksheet
 - b) Photo copy of Transfer certificate
 - c) Photo copy of Testimonial Certificate

VI. EXAMINATION

- 1. There will be 1st Terminal, 2nd Terminal and Promotion Examinations.
- 2. Pass mark will be 40 including internal assessment in all subjects.
- 3. If a student fails to appear for the promotion Examination on account of medical reasons, his/her promotion/selection will be decided collectively by the Principal and Lecturers based on his/her previous term examination results.
- 4. Students should attain at least 80% attendance to sit for the Promotion Examination.
- 5. Internal assessment marks from 1st Term and 2nd Term is compulsory for promotion examination results.
- 6. Absent fine is Rs. 100/- per subject.
- 7. Evaluation for Promotion

The school follows the Integrated Evaluation Scheme as introduced by the MBSE. The detailed working scheme is as follows:

Internal mark is split into three areas namely- Internal Examination, Attendance, Practical. Internal Examination and attendance will carry 25% of the internal marks respectively (5 marks each) Assignment/Project/Field work / Practical (subjects with practical) will carry 50% of the internal marks (10 marks).

The marks obtained by the students in the term-end examinations only will be taken into account for calculating their internal examination marks. The higher of the two scores will be taken with the condition that the student must have had appeared in both the term-end examinations.

VIII. DISCIPLINARY RULES

1. **Smoking** :Smoking is strictly prohibited within and outside the school premises while the student is wearing school uniform

2. **Substance use**: A student who is found in possession of or intoxicated with drugs, alcohol or grape wine in or outside the school compound while wearing the school uniform will be given punishment as under:

 1^{st} instance :Suspension from the school for 1 (one) month. 2^{nd} instance :Transfer certificate will be issued.

3. **Truancy** :Staying away from the school or roaming outside the school during school hours without permission is strictly prohibited. If such an act is committed by a student, punishment will be given as under:

1st instance :A fine of Rs.50/2nd instance :Suspension from the school for 1 (one) week.
3rd instance :Transfer certificate will be issued.
Note: Absconding from class without permission will be treated as truancy.

4. **Make-up, Jewelry, etc.:** Wearing make-up such as lipstick, colored lip gloss, mascara, eye liner, eye pencil, nail polish, colored lenses etc. is not allowed. Wearing necklaces, rings, earrings, bangles, chain, fancy hair bands and clips etc. is also prohibited.

Punishment:

- a) jewelry worn by the student will be confiscated and will not be returned.
- b) A student found wearing make-up will either wash it off or be sent home for the day
- 5. **Haircut/hair style**: Boys should keep their hair neat and trim. Girls with long hair should keep their hair neatly tied in pony-tail with a simple black band. All the girls should keep their hair/fringe away from their face using simple black hair bands and black clips. Fancy hair style, hair coloring/bleaching for boys and girls are not allowed.

6. Late coming : Late comers will be fined as under:

- 7. **Absence** : Absence without permission will be fined Rs. 10/ per day. If a student is absent for 3 consecutive days without permission, he/she will not be allowed to resume classes without the written permission from the Principal. Parents/Guardians are expected to report themselves to the class teacher stating the reasons for their children's absence.
- 8. **Stealing** : A student caught or found stealing will be asked to return /replace the stolen items. Parents / Guardians will be

informed and it could even lead to expulsion depending upon the severity of the case.

9. School uniform: Students should come to the school with clean, complete and proper uniform. If a student is found wearing improper uniform, punishment will be given as under:

 1^{st} instance : A fine of Rs 10/ 2^{nd} instance : A fine of Rs 20/-

 3^{rd} instance : A fine of Rs 50/-

- 10. Attendance : All the students are expected to maintain regularity in attending classes. Students failing to secure 80% attendance will not be allowed to appear in the final examination.
- 11. **Mobile Phone**: Students are not allowed to bring mobile phone to school. If a mobile phone is found, it will be confiscated. Parents of the students have to pay a fine of Rs 300/- to get it back, after a period of 1-6 months depending on the case
- 12. Unfair practices in examination: Practice of unfair means /cheating in examination will result in cancellation of answer paper.
- 13. Other misconducts: The following misconducts are strictly prohibited:
 - a) Writing, curving, scribbling, scratching and spitting on furniture, walls or any part of the school building.
 - b) Eating/chewing pan, tobacco products, shikhar, etc.
 - c) Eating/chewing anything during class.
 - d) Throwing rubbish/garbage/waste paper inside the school compound is strictly prohibited.

- e) If a student damages school properties, he/she will pay for replacement of the damaged property.
- 14. **Tattoo** : Tattoos on any part of the body is prohibited.

IX. GUIDELINES

Besides the above-mentioned rules and regulations, the school also strictly follows the Guidelines for school uniform and Discipline formulated by the Directorate of School Education as per Govt. Circular No.F.23012/1/MISC/10DEO(A)28 dated 18.11.2010.

The Guidelines are given below for strict compliance of the students:

1. SCHOOL DRESS / SCHOOL UNIFORM

Students should go to school in proper and decent school uniform. Every student is expected to look smart and clean in his/her school dress. School uniform should be neat, tidy and shoes should be well polished.

a) Skirts:

- i) Only pleated skirts should be worn for school uniforms. No tight-fitting designs are accepted for school uniforms.
- ii) Skirt/tunic must cover from the navel up to the knee properly.
- iii) Skirts should not be worn at low waist.

b) Pants/Trousers:

i) Wearing uniform pants at low waist is strongly disliked and is not allowed.

- ii) Extreme narrow bottom pants and extreme beltbottom pants are not allowed.
- iii) Fixation for bottom line of pants/trousers.

c) Shirts:

Shirts should be properly tucked in at all times while dressed in school uniforms.

d) Necktie:

Necktie should be properly fixed on the neck at all times while dressed in school uniforms.

2. HAIRSTYLE

- a) Bleaching and coloring of hair is strictly prohibited for both boys and girls. Only black dye may be used if and when circumstances demand.
- b) Boys cut and over short hair is strictly prohibited for high school and higher Secondary School girls.
- c) Shaved haircut, bald cut, (Bruch-cut over the ears) bald haircut and growing long hair is strictly prohibited for boys.
- d) Spiky hair and fancy hair style of any kind is strictly prohibited.
- e) No student shall keep his/her hair in any manner which can make the hair look unusual or over stylish than the normal student look.
- f) Applying of hair gel of any kinds (super hard, water gloss, wet look, etc.) and over oiling of hair is strictly prohibited and hair should not be too dry either.

3. TATTOOS AND BODY MAKINGS

- a) Imprinting of tattoos on any parts of the body is strictly prohibited.
- b) Body piercing and making artificial mole on any part of the body is strictly prohibited.

4. USE OF COSMETICS AND ORNAMENTS

- a) Students are not permitted to bring or decorate themselves with ornaments or any kinds at schools. This includes, rings, nose rings, necklaces, earrings, bangles, chains, rouges, payals, bracelet, wristbands etc.
- b) Bringing and applying of cosmetics and make-ups of any kind is not permitted at school and hence strictly prohibited. This includes face powder, perfumes, lipsticks, eyebrows, eyeliner, kajal, nail polish, colored lip gloss etc.

5. MOBILE PHONES

Bringing and using of mobile phones or any other electronic gadgets such as pendrive, walkman, discman, ipods, etc. is strictly prohibited at school unless prior permission is obtained from the school authority for special occasion or for school functions.

6. TOBACCO

Consumption, bringing and possession of tobacco and other tobacco products such as tiranga, cigarettes, zarda, raja, khaini, baba, supari, betel nut etc. is strictly prohibited at school.

7. OBSCENE OBJECTS

Bringing obscene objects of any kind to the school in the form of cassettes, disk, literature, pictures, stickers, posters, stamps, books, magazines etc. which can spoil a child's moral psychology and character is strictly prohibited at school.

Posting/distribution of any stills/video that can ruin the teachers'/Faculty/fellow students of our school reputation to public is strictly prohibited.

PENALISATION FOR OFFENDERS OR VIOLATORS

- a) 1st Violation: Imposition of fine up to Rs 500/-
- b) 2nd Violation: Imposition of fine up to Rs 1000/-
- c) 3rd Violation: Expulsion from school.

Special Note: If a student is expelled due to violation of any of the above rules and regulations, remarks in the character Certificate be mentioned as 'Violation of School Rules and Regulations'.

Notes:

- a) For penalty and punishment of offenders, the school will decide whether to follow the school rules or the Guidelines given by the Directorate of School Education. The decision will be made according to the situation by the principal, Disciplinary Committee and lecturers concerned.
- b) If a student behaves in any undesirable/unacceptable manner which is not mentioned in the school rules and the Guidelines, disciplinary action will be taken by the school as deemed necessary.

X. CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES 1. NATIONAL CADET CORPS:

NCC was started in 2001. It aims to develop character, discipline, and the ideals of selfless service amongst the students. In the beginning, it was only for boys with 50 cadets. From 2017 onwards, it was widened for girls with 25 cadets.

The NCC has been organizing different activities and events. NCC has actively participated and performed many activities including CATC camp, attending program outside the state. In such program, effort is always given and has exemplary performance in various activities.

There are several esteemed armies from the school NCC. GCHSS NCC has molded many students to become an in-spiring army and navy of their dreams. It has been recorded that 2 NCC cadets from GCHSS have become Army Officer namely- Major MS Dawngsanga ang Lt Lalruatsanga, beside these, more than 50 cadets have joined the Armed forces which is truly a milestone for GCHSS NCC. NCC has commendable services and has enthusiastically contributed in the regulation of the school rules. They actively take part and responsible in the Annual Sports and Mizoram Higher Secondary School Games. NCC also engaged in the Republic Day and Independence Day with flying colors. Beside these, they take part in different important events. Annually, enrolment for the new NCC Cadet is opened for the newly admitted students of Class XI.
